1708 Agri Startups Supported with Technical & Financial Assistance under RKVY's Innovation & Agri-Entrepreneurship Development Program



Union Minister for Agriculture and Farmers' Welfare, Shri Shivraj Singh Chouhan told Rajya Sabha that the Government is committed to promote Agri-startups in India by offering both financial and technical support within the agriculture and allied sectors. For this, the Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers' Welfare (MoA&FW) has been running an "Innovation and Agri-Entrepreneurship Development" program under the Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY) since 2018-19. This initiative aims to encourage innovation and agri-entrepreneurship by providing financial and technical backing to nurture the startup ecosystem in the country. To date, under the initiative, 5 Knowledge Partners (KPs) and 24 RKVY Agribusiness Incubators (R-ABIs) have been established for the training and incubation of agri-startups.

Startups can get financial assistance up to Rs. 25 Lakhs

Under this program, financial support is available up to Rs. 5 lakhs at the idea/pre-seed stage and up to Rs. 25 lakhs at the seed stage for entrepreneurs/startups in the agriculture and allied sectors. This funding helps them in launching their products, services, business platforms and supports scaling up their operations. Start-ups receive training and incubation from their respective KPs and R-ABIs. Additionally, the Government of India organizes national-level events such as agri-startup conclaves, agri fairs, exhibitions, webinars & workshops to promote agri-startups and connect them with various stakeholders.

Formation of Agri Accelerator Fund of Rs. 300 crores

Furthermore, the Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers' Welfare has approved the establishment of an Agri Accelerator Fund of Rs. 300 crore for three years starting from 2023-24 to support the agriculture start-up ecosystem. The Agri Accelerator Fund is designed to scale up start-ups with innovative technologies that have the potential to transform the agriculture sector.

So far, 1,708 agri-startups across various fields in agriculture and allied sectors have received technical and financial support totalling Rs. 122.50 crores from 2019-20 to 2023-24 under the Innovation and Agri-Entrepreneurship Development program.

These agri-startups are at different stages of development, from initial idea to scaling and growth. They work in diverse areas including precision agriculture, farm mechanization, agri logistics and supply chain, waste-to-wealth, organic farming, animal husbandry, dairy and fisheries.
