- University of Petroleum & Energy Studies (UPES), Dehradun
- BLDE, Karnataka
- Pranveer Singh Institute of Technology, Kanpur
- GSSS Institute of Engineering and Technology for Women, Karnataka
- Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya (Central University), Bilaspur

It is worth noting that i-TBIs (Inclusive TBI) is a 3-year initiative supported by the Department of Science and Technology for educational institutions that help in fostering innovation & entrepreneurship among students, entrepreneurs, faculties and nearby communities.

During his address, Dr. Jitendra Singh highlighted Prime Minister Narendra Modi's vision for the 'Startup India - Stand up India' initiative, under which DST launched NIDHI in 2016. NIDHI was introduced to bridge the gap between academic institutions and industry, facilitating the transformation of cutting-edge research into market-ready products.
