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INTRODUCTION

The SAMARTH Innovation and Incubation Induction Program, initiated by Pusa Krishi Incubator under the Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers' Welfare (MoA & FW), is a pioneering effort to strengthen agribusiness incubation in India. Launched as part of the Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana - Remunerative Approaches for Agriculture and Allied Sector Rejuvenation (RKVY-RAFTAAR) scheme in 2017-18, SAMARTH addresses the growing need for structured support to agri-startups and incubators. With business incubation recognized globally as a catalyst for economic growth, this program aims to empower incubator managers and foster innovation in the agricultural sector, aligning with the Start-up India initiative.



PROGRAM OVERVIEW

SAMARTH focuses on training and handholding Agribusiness Incubators (RABIs) established under RKVY-RAFTAAR. The program equips incubator managers with best practices in planning, management, ecosystem building, stakeholder engagement, funding, and policy implementation.

The initiative targets incubator managers and stakeholders, offering workshops, on-site support, and structured programs like business plan competitions and accelerators. A special emphasis is placed on supporting agri-enterprises that enhance the agricultural value chain.



-  To develop an innovation-driven economic process in the agri-sector.
-  To establish a robust network of agri-incubators across India.
-  To ensure the long-term sustainability of agri-incubation programs.
-  To support agri-startups within each incubator.
-  To train a new generation of skilled Agri Business Incubator Managers.
